

BIOSECURITY POLICY

Policy Statement:

2 Sisters Food Group is the trading name for Boparan Holdings Limited, which owns directly and indirectly UK & EU companies constituting the Boparan Group of Companies.

The Boparan Group is committed to ensuring that the risk of transfer of disease organisms of bird and human importance through general activities of animal handling are minimized as far as possible.

Scope:

All meat including farmed fin fish used in Boparan Group companies.

Background:

The risk of disease transfer through visits and daily work activities related to animal handling is a real and serious issue. It is therefore critical that all personnel involved in animal handling and all visitors to live animal sites, are aware of the biosecurity rules and that they are adhered to at all times. The Boparan Group expects its supply base to implement appropriate biosecurity procedures which are regularly reviewed and updated as required to ensure that legislative including farm animal welfare legislation, customer and farm assurance requirements are met. It also expects that controls as required by legislation for new or “exotic” diseases are maintained. These standards, and associated training, need to apply both at the farming level and at the kill sites.
